

Maternity and Partners

We are trialling a change to current arrangements in the ante-natal clinic

Your partner or 'significant other' can:



Attend your booking scan (normally 10-12 weeks into your pregnancy)



Attend your anomaly scan (20 weeks into your pregnancy)

They will be asked to:



Wait outside the department until they are called to come in for the scan.



Leave the department as soon as the scan is complete.

You will both:



Be asked questions about your health. If either of you are feeling unwell or have had symptoms of any infection, you will not be able to come into the department.



Need to wear a face covering at all times during your visit.



Maintain social distancing of two metres including in the scanning room - where a chair will be allocated for your partner. This cannot be moved.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION



Children can not attend the antenatal clinic with you



Anyone not following guidelines or compromising the safety of other patients and staff will be asked to leave



If either of you have had symptoms of coronavirus within 14 days of your appointment (continuous cough, high temperature, loss of sense of smell or taste) you must contact the Antenatal clinic and re-arrange.
