## **P** Car Parking

Patients and visitors can use Car Parks ① ④ ⑤a ⑥ ⑦a & ⑩  
You must pay on exit at one of the yellow pay stations.

## **£** Financial Help

You may be able to claim financial help for travel, which includes parking charges, on a national level through the NHS Low Income Scheme. Go to [www.nhs.uk](http://www.nhs.uk) and search 'NHS Low Income Scheme' or ask our Assistance and Complaints team in the main entrance.

## Disabled Parking

Disabled drivers can use Car Parks ② and ③, charges apply. If you are eligible for help with costs associated with healthcare then you may be able to claim parking charges back. Log onto [www.nhs.uk](http://www.nhs.uk) and search for 'NHS Low Income Scheme' or ask for information at our Patient Accounts desk in the main entrance opposite the shop.

## **M** Mult-Visit Pass

You can buy a pass that lets you in and out of our car parks for 14 visits. There is no time limit per visit and the card runs out after the 14th visit, it has no 'expiry date'. The pass costs £17.50 (that's £1.25 per visit) and can be bought from our 'Shop@theRoyal'.
